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Summary Annual Report for the INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SHEET METAL, AIR, RAIL, AND TRANSPORTATION WORKERS ("SMART") LOCAL UNION NO. 36 PENSION FUND

This is the summary annual report for the INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SHEET METAL, AIR, RAIL, AND TRANSPORTATION WORKERS ("SMART") LOCAL NO. 36 PENSION FUND, EIN 43-0727853, Plan number 001 for the period January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust (benefits are provided in whole from trust funds). Plan expenses were \$17,071,667. These included benefit payments of \$15,862,315, administrative expenses of \$1,209,352, and \$0 in other expenses. A total of 2,740 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although some may not have earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$215,893,776 as of December 31, 2016, compared to \$202,824,895 as of January 1, 2016. During the year the plan experienced an increase or (decrease) in its net assets of \$13,068,881. This increase or (decrease) includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income (loss) of \$30,140,548, including employer contributions of \$17,151,710, employee contributions of \$0, gains or (losses) of \$2,274,801 from the sale of assets, and net earnings from investments of \$10,296,334.

An actuary's statement shows that enough money was contributed to the plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.
